IN-PERSON GATHERING FAQs

When will we begin in-person gatherings?

Our campus is now open for worship at 10am on Sundays and Life Groups meet throughout the week. Register online at oakwoodbc.org to save your spot.

Do I really have to register to attend the service?

Yes, you do need to register for our Sunday worship services so we can safely fill the seating capacity according to the CDC guidelines. Registration opens up every Sunday via oakwoodbc.org.

What time should I arrive for the service?

The main entrance to the Worship Center will open at 9:45am to begin seating. When you arrive, please park in the main parking lot, and follow the direction of our guest services team. To ensure check-in goes smoothly, please follow the directions in your registration confirmation email and have the Church Center App open on your mobile device with your barcode ready to scan as you enter.

Can I sit with my family/friends?

If you've been sharing life together outside of Sunday, you are welcome to sit with each other. Please meet up with your friends and family outside before you enter the lobby. Groups need to enter the Worship Center together, so please make sure everyone has arrived before you enter.

How long will the service last?

Our service will be about 60 minutes in length.

Is Oakwood Kids open?

Yes! Oakwood Kids is open and available for birth-5th grade! We can't wait to see you. Your child's safety is our priority! Safety procedures and precautions for our children's area are available in the <u>Oakwood Kids FAQs</u>.

Will I be able to take my children into the adult service?

Yes, your children can sit with you in the service. We would love for you to participate in singing as a family, and we have special children's content available via the Oakwood app for them during the sermon. All that is required is a mobile device and a set of headphones.

When will the Oakwood Students open?

Do I have to wear a mask?
